








<p>Week Beginning: 3rd June Book: Mr Seahorse The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Understand that seahorses are unique in the natural world as the dad carries the eggs/babies. - Think about the role fathers and other significant males play in our lives. (Father's Day) - RE: share what they are thankful for in the world. <p><i>Key Vocabulary: babies, eggs, pouch, father</i></p> 	<p>Week Beginning: 10th June Story: Sharing a Shell The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Understand that sharing and team work are important. - Learn about the animals that live in rock pools/on the sea shore and link back to the visit to the aquarium. - RE: Learn about the creation of the world and what God made. <p><i>Key Vocabulary: rock pool, crab, aneome, brush, shell</i></p> 	<p>Week Beginning: 17th June Theme: The Snail and the Whale The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Understand that even if they are young/small they can help others. - Learn about the different places the snail and the whale visited. - Begin transition work preparing for reception. - RE: think about the environment and how to take care of it. <p><i>Key Vocabulary: iceberg, volcano, bay, dock, rock, island</i></p> 	<p>Week Beginning: 24th June Theme: Cuddly Dudley The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Continue transition work preparing for reception. - Think about times they have needed to have a break from others. - Learn about the north and south poles and the people and animals they might see there. <p><i>Key Vocabulary: arctive, Antarctic, penguin, space</i></p> 
<p>Week Beginning: 1st June Story: The Singing Mermaid The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Understand that we should celebrate the talents of others but allow them to use it as they choose. - Learn about mermaids and other mythical sea creatures. - RE: Explore the world around them based on the retelling of the creation story. <p><i>Key Vocabulary: tail, talent, sing,</i></p> 	<p>Week Beginning: 8th July Book: Barry the Fish with Fingers The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Think about the things we use our fingers for. - Understand how people are physically different to fish. - Make finger puppets. - Understand that it is important to celebrate the abilities of others. - RE: think about what they what they would like to see in the world <p><i>Key Vocabulary: fingers, fins,</i></p> 	<p>Week Beginning: 15th July Book: The Rainbow Fish The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Discuss what the Rainbow fish learns about the importance of sharing and not boasting. - Identify and discuss colours found all around us. - Paint pictures of rainbow fish. - RE: learn how they can look after the world and be good stewards. <p><i>Key vocabulary: share, boast,</i></p> 	<p>Week Beginning: 22nd July Book: Starry Eyed Stan The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Talk about their gifts, talents and abilities. - Understand that it is important not to boast about things. - Compare starfish to other sea creatures. - Celebrate the end of their year in Nursery <p><i>Key Vocabulary: eel, startfish, crab,</i></p>
